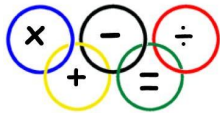


# Information from 4D

## Maths



We are continuing to investigate the place value of numbers, e.g. that in 4321 the 3 means 3 hundred, but in 3498 the 3 means 3 thousand. This week we are ordering numbers up to 9999. We are multiplying and dividing numbers by 10 and 100 by moving the digits to the left when multiplying and to the right when dividing and we are continuing sequences by adding or subtracting 10 or 20 or 100 or 200 or a mixture of the 2 from a starting number, e.g. here I am adding 20. 2567, 2587, 2607 etc.

## English



This week we are starting handwriting. I will teach the children to join and I hope to see lots of lovely joined handwriting by the end of the year. We will finish off our poetry unit by choosing 1 poem to write out as a poem. We will then be starting a unit on fiction. This week we will be thinking and describing different settings. I will expect to see and hear lots of adjectives and adverbs, e.g. the branches of the tree waved violently in the wind. I will also expect to see sentences starting in a variety of different ways. E.g. As the waves broke gently on the shore, the gulls circled above. Gently, the sparkling snow fell on to the hills.
