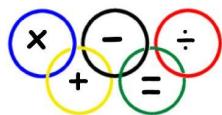


Information from 4D

Maths



This week we will continue with revising the 4x table and the associated division facts. The children are also learning the pairs of numbers that total 20

Our other work this week will be to do with measuring. The children will be measuring how long things are, how heavy things are and how much liquid a container can hold (the capacity). They will use ml, l, mm, cm, m, g and kg and some will begin to look at the relationship between these. We will be doing lots of estimating and then practical work to check these estimates. Cooking is an excellent activity that the children can do at home to practice all of these skills.

English



Spellings this week will be revision of all the rules that the children have covered so far this term. The test on Friday will consist of 10 words chosen at random from all the spellings that have so far been given.

We will continue with our work on non-fiction texts. By the end of the week the children will have produced a page about an imaginary dinosaur. They will need to use all their knowledge of the features of non-fiction texts to do this successfully. E.g. headings, diagrams, fact files, paragraphs about key pieces of information and writing in the 3rd person.
