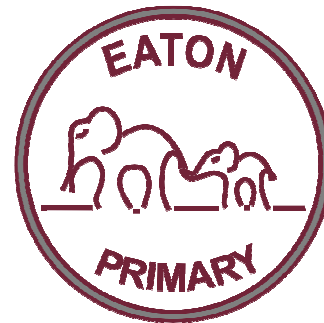

Craftcubs - Breakfast and After School Club

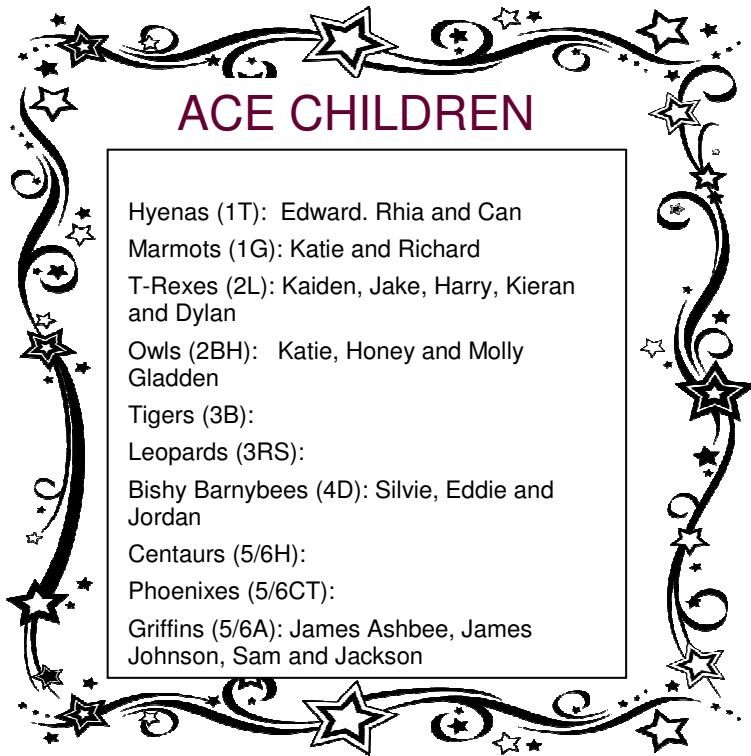
It is really important that all booking forms are received by Monday next week. Some after school club sessions are becoming very popular and we have to limit places.
