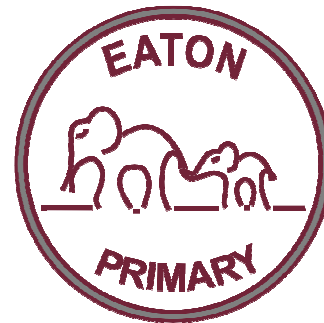

Our Choir at Wymondham Youth Music Festival

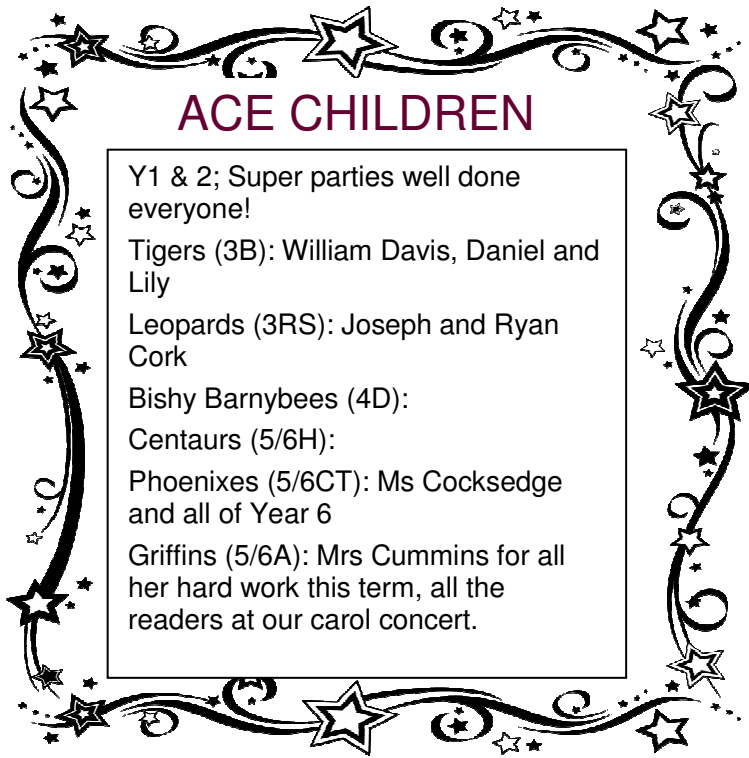
As a token of their appreciation WYM have donated £100 to school for our music department...well done children in the choir...& Mrs Earl too!
